CPS Will Implement Full Remote Learning for the 1st Quarter

Earlier this month, Chicago Public School (CPS) announced that all students will begin the coming school year learning at home. Throughout our response to COVID-19, our top priority has been, and will continue to be, keeping our students and school communities safe. The remote learning framework will provide CPS the flexibility to begin the school year learning at home and transition to hybrid learning once our public health experts determine it is safe to do so.

Families should expect an experience that mirrors what students would normally experience at school. Teachers will take attendance daily, use Google Suite tools to post work and host live instruction, and be available during school hours to provide students with feedback, support, and host parent conferences as needed. This will help teachers better understand individual student learning and provide support in a timely manner.

School-wide Expectations During Remote Learning

- 1. Make sure your device is charged; test your sound make sure its working
- 2. Make sure to have breakfast before 7:45am (universal lunch time will be 11:00am—12:00 pm)
 - No eating/snacks during remote learning time •
- 3. Students must be dressed in uniform every day
- Find a quiet location free from distractions (away from your siblings and family) 4.
 - Have an appropriate workspace where you can sit (table and chair)
 - Have your back to a wall (if possible)
 - Have materials ready (notebook, books, pencil, workbooks, etc.)
 - Have your master passwords written in your notebook to reference everyday
 - Students should be the only one in the virtual class (not your pets or family members)
- 5. Follow your agenda for the day

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- 6. Log on 3-4 minutes prior to start time of 7:45am
 - Loo in to every Departmental class sessions throughout the day, 3-4 minutes before class begins
- 7. Be fully engaged/ active participant for the duration of the lesson/class/day
- 8. Use of technology must be limited to remote learning purposes (use equipment as outlined in the CPS Acceptable Use Policy)
- 9. Be supportive of each other in this new way of learning
 - Be patient with yourself and your teachers •
 - Inform your teacher when you do not understand; be your advocate
 - Check your gradebook regularly to monitor your own progress
- 11. Take care of yourself, have a set sleeping routine, eat well, be ready, and have FUN learning
- 12. Remember we care about you and want you to be successful, we are on your team!
